**PROJECT:** Achieving Surrender of an Environmental Permit

## **WORKS**

- Site reporting with intrusive works to achieve license surrender
- Liaison with the regulatory authorities regarding specific requirements
- Undertaking of site reconnaissance and photographic records to design and refine further works
- Undertaking of site investigation works to produce a Site Condition Report

## **SYNOPSIS**

TRM assisted in achieving surrender of an environmental permit at a former manufacturing facility.

A preliminary site visit led to reconnaissance works and construction of a photographic record of the premises.

This in turn led to site investigation works, comprising of soils logging to British Standards; groundwater monitoring/sampling, and soil sampling and analysis to produce a profile across the site of any potential contamination. Industry-specific analysis was undertaken to assess the effects of historic manufacturing operations.



## **OUTCOME**

Comparisons with a previous IPPC application Phase 1B report yielded a list of recommendations for further action, without the requirements for extensive remedial works. The actions were critical to achieving the aim of environmental permit surrender.
